
## HonorsGradU Scholarship Application Checklist

## **PROJECT PHASES**

- Look, listen, & learn: Become aware of your community's story and a current issue, considering how you can open dialogue with
- people to find out their needs. Ask tons of questions: Dig deeper by starting with what you know
- & building on what you have. Understand the problem or process: Research by conducting
  - interviews, reading articles, watching videos, or analyzing data. As you look for sources, consider how you might be profoundly inclusive. You will be asked for 5 sources with specific links where possible. Navigate ideas: Synthesize what you have learned by producing a
  - strategy plan, keeping the community at the center of the work. Link to strategy plan form: www.honorsgradu.com/scholarship Create a prototype: Define whether it is a tangible object, digital work, piece of art, or an action, event, or system (if it is an action, event, or system, prepare a short < 1-minute video that shows how it

works).

- Highlight & fix: What is working about your project so far and what
- are areas that have or still need fixing? Launch to an audience: Share a video reflection (see the "Multimedia Required" section for details).
