FOUR-SQUARE SLAP JACK

Objective: Be the first to put your hand down on any paper <u>except</u> for the one that was called out by the caller.

Set Up: Print off the shape pages. You can color them, print them on different color paper, or keep them black and white. Tape the papers to a table, floor, or other flat surface. As a group, decide the point total you'd like to play to (first player to 10, 15, 20... wins).

Game Play: Players must keep their hands behind their back until a category has been called out.

Once the caller has called out the category for the round, players try to be the first to put their hand on a page other than the one that was called.

For example: If the caller calls "stars", players must put their hand on the heart, triangle, or circle papers.

The first player to put their hand down wins a point for the round. If a player puts their hand down on the category that is called, they lose a point.

The first player to reach the agreed upon point total wins the game!

Other Ways to Play:

- Color each page of shapes a color or print off pages onto colored paper; the caller can then call out for players to hit either a shape or a color.
- Players can hit the category that was called out by the caller. Hitting any other page will result in losing a point.
- The caller can call out two categories, and players must put a hand on each of the categories called OR must put a hand on the two categories that were not called.

*Consider laminating the pages to re-use and re-play!
