

QUESTION OF THE DAY

- Imagine you woke up one day and were the size of a ladybug. What would you spend your day doing? Is there anywhere you would want to go that you couldn't go as a full size human?
- Your clothes suddenly become stubborn and opinionated. What do you do when your socks refuse to be put on and your pants try to walk away?
- You realize your pets can speak. What is the first conversation you'll have with them?
- The fruits and veggies in your fridge come to life at night. Write about what kind of adventures they have.
- Rewrite a fairy tale from the antagonist's perspective.
- You wake up and discover you have grown wings over night. Write about your adventures.
- Imagine you are a grumpy pet cat. Write about your day and the crazy things your humans do.
- Think of an animal for every letter of the alphabet. Take the letters from your first name and write a short blip about those animals getting into trouble.
- What is something you really want to try, but are too afraid or nervous to do? Think of 2-3 ways you could get up the courage to try that thing.
- What if every time you sneezed, you would get transported somewhere else. Where would you want to be transported to?
- Which kitchen appliance is the most important? Write an argument for that appliance trying to convince everyone why it is the most important.
- Choose a career/job you are interested in. Write a job description **without** actually saying the job title– list job duties, schooling needed, pay, etc.
- Imagine you got hired to be a food tester. What company would you want to taste-test for? Describe both the yummiest and yuckiest things you've had to taste at work.
- Write a short story that contains the following things: a clumsy giraffe, a bike, a pair of red shoes, a rain storm, and a mischievous 8 year old boy.
- What is something you really want? Write a paragraph trying to convince your parents to let you have that thing.
- Write a story about a flock of birds who spends their day in a tree by an elementary school– what do they talk about? What kinds of things do they see?
- Finish this sentence: "If I were teacher for a day..."
- You receive an award for being the best at something. What is your award for and what makes you the best at that thing?
- Think of a common problem people have, and invent a product that will help that problem. Describe what your invention does/how it solves the problem, what it looks like, and how much you will charge for people to buy it.
